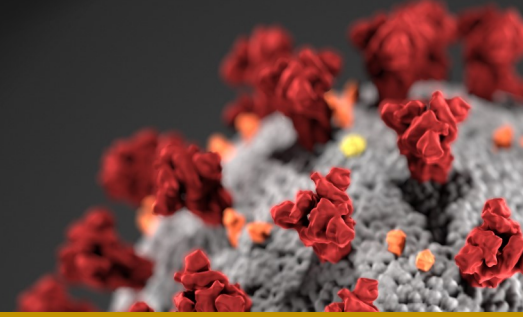


COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **April 17** — The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention issued guidance for:
 - [Rideshare, taxi, limo and other passenger drivers-for-hire](#)
 - [Food and grocery pick-up and delivery drivers](#)
- **April 17** — Governor Newsom signed an [executive order](#) that allows for temporary waivers to certain foster youth programs to ensure continuity of care in response to COVID-19. This includes a 60-day waiver to allow for flexibility in the emergency placement of foster youth and ensures that foster youth have access to critical programs and technology in situations where the juvenile court case may still be pending.
- **April 17** — the [County launched the new Daily Update](#) which will provide important news, information and resources related to COVID-19. The Daily Update will be shared Monday through Friday.
- **April 16** — President Trump issued [guidelines for Opening Up America Again](#) which is a three-phased approach based on advice from public health experts. This proposed approach is designed to consider up-to-date data and readiness, mitigate risk of resurgence, protect the vulnerable and could be implemented statewide or at a county-level based on the discretion of state governors.
