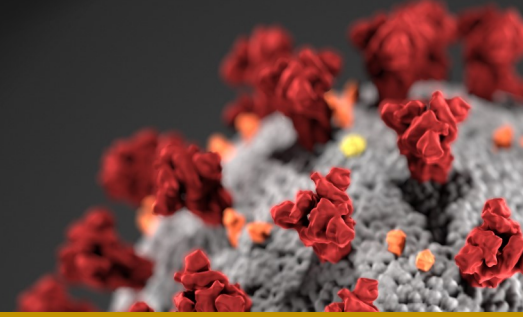


COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- The San Bernardino County's Acting Health Officer issued an [order clarifying the 'Stay-at-Home' order](#) relating to lodging facilities which allow hotels, condominiums or other units to continue operations only under the following circumstances:
 - To house workers performing essential functions.
 - To assist in COVID-19 mitigation and containment measures meant to protect homeless populations.
- **April 2** — Governor Newsom announced the following:
 - Federal [loans for small business and displaced workers](#) impacted by COVID-19. The state will be allocating loan funds for small business that do not qualify for federal loans, including low wealth or undocumented immigrant communities.
 - Launching of [OnwardCA.org](#) platform which will connect COVID-19 displaced workers with job openings in critical industries.
 - Executive order [restricting water shutoffs](#) for homes and small businesses during COVID-19 crisis.
- **April 2** — The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention released strategies on how to [maximize the existing supply](#) of personal protective equipment (PPE). This guidance includes the following resources:
 - Instructions for use and an excel sheet [PPE burn-rate calculator](#) to assist healthcare facilities in optimizing the use of PPE.
