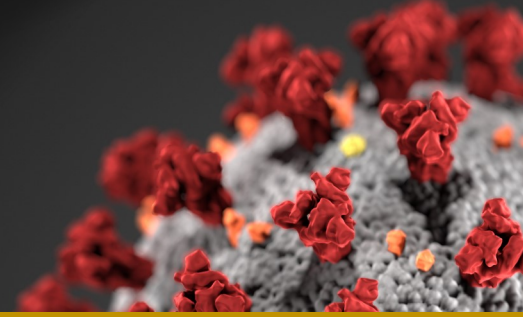


COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **April 2** — National Institutes of Health released their [NIAID \(National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases\) strategic plan for COVID-19 research](#).
- **April 22** — the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued:
 - Updated [guidance for homeless service providers](#)
 - [Principals of contract tracing](#)
 - Confirmation of [two pet cats infected with COVID-19](#)
- **April 22** — [Governor Newsom announced](#) plans to allow hospitals and health systems to resume delayed medical care for Californians – such as heart valve replacements, angioplasty and tumor removals, and key preventive care services, such as colonoscopies – which were deferred as the state’s health care delivery systems prepared for a surge of COVID-19 patients
