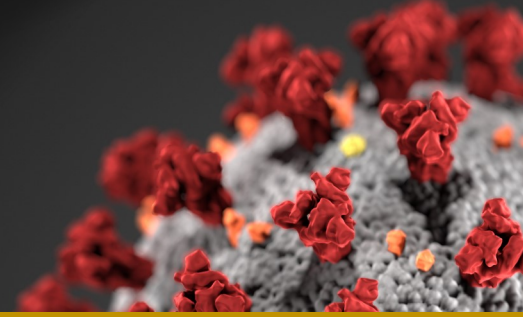


COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **May 11** - the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued updated guidance on:
 - [Point-of-care testing for COVID-19](#)

- **May 11** - the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) [issued an alert to help keep the dental industry safe during COVID-19](#).
- **May 11** - the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) [revised the policy for COVID-19 tests](#) during the public health emergency.
- **May 11** - the [U.S. Department of Labor issued guidance](#) announcing the availability of \$100 million in short-term compensation grant funds for states.
- **May 11** - Governor Newsom, along with other governors and legislative leaders from the five western pact states, [issued a letter to Congressional leadership requesting \\$1 trillion in direct and flexible relief](#) to preserve core government services like public health, public safety and public schools.
