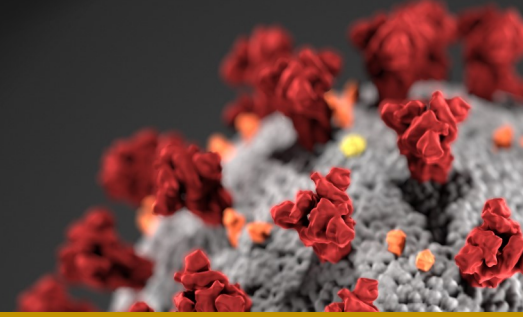


COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **May 25** - The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) announced [counties statewide may reopen places of worship for religious services and retail stores](#).
- **May 25** - The county issued [guidelines allowing places of worship to resume services](#).
- **May 24** - The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) released information on:
 - [CDC diagnostic test for COVID-19](#).
 - [How to discontinue home isolation](#).
- **May 23** - The county announced [restaurants, stores and malls are cleared to reopen](#).
- **May 22** - The CDC released [recommendations for communities of faith](#).
- **May 22** - The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services announced a [nearly \\$4.9 billion distribution to skilled nursing facilities \(SNF\) impacted by COVID-19](#).
- **May 22** - CDPH issued an [all facilities letter \(AFL\) for testing of Health Care Personnel \(HCP\) and residents at SNFs](#).
- **May 22** - Governor Newsom announced the launch of [California Connected – California’s contact tracing program and public awareness campaign](#).
- **May 21** - The CDC issued guidance on [key information to collect during a case interview](#) for contact tracing.
