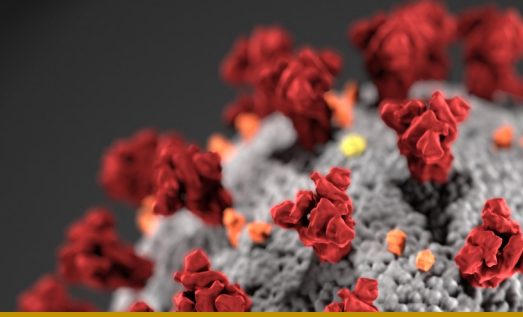


COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **May 4** - the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued [COVID-19 contact tracing training guidance and resources](#).
- **May 1** - the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) published:
 - An [Emergency Use Authorization \(EUA\) for the antiviral drug remdesivir](#) as treatment of COVID-19.
 - [Updated guidance relating to COVID-19 convalescent plasma](#) applications and donor requirements.
- **May 1** - the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) issued [recommendations for restaurants and other businesses offering curbside pickup and takeout service](#).
- **May 1** - Board of Supervisors Chairman Curt Hagman announced:
 - A plan for a phased reopening of the county's economy will be issued during the May 5 Board of Supervisors' meeting.
 - The County is committing up to \$30 million in federal COVID-19 funding to support businesses throughout the county through a Small Business Rapid Recovery Program.
- **May 1** - the County Chief Executive Officer, Gary McBride, extended the moratorium on residential and commercial evictions to May 31.
- **May 1** - the County announced that COVID-19 serology testing is being conducted at Arrowhead Regional Medical Center.
