
COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **June 10** The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) released <u>Guidance for Providing Mass Care</u> <u>during a Pandemic</u> which includes:
 - A Mass Care/Emergency Assistance Pandemic Planning Considerations Guide.
 - COVID-19 Emergency Managers Best Practices.
- June 10 The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued:
 - Recommendations for <u>Using Telehealth to Expand Access to Essential Health Services during COVID-19</u>.
 - <u>Updated Financial Resources</u> for public health agencies and partners.
 - Information for Laboratories about COVID-19.
- **June 10** The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) released <u>Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) for Non Long-Term Care Facilities and Intermediate Care Facilities for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities.</u>
