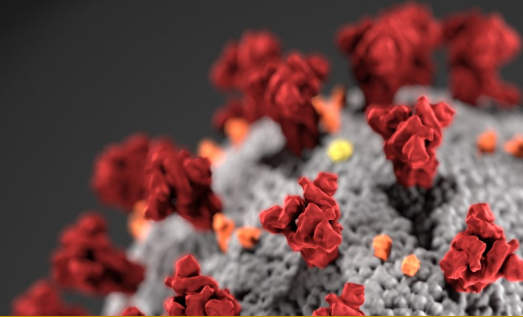


COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

- **June 15** – The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued guidance on:

- **June 15** – The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) issued news releases on:

- **June 15** - Governor Newsom:
