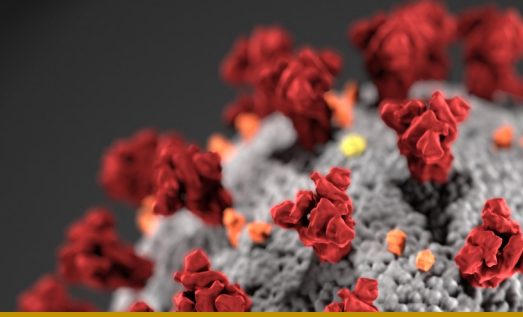


COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

- **June 3** - The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) released:
