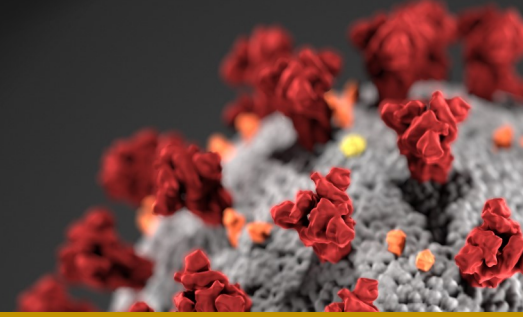


COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **June 9** - The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued [guidance for safely Visiting Parks and Recreational Facilities](#).
- **June 8** - The CDC issued revised guidance on:
 - [Running Essential Errands](#) such as grocery shopping, take-out, banking and getting gas.
 - [Staffing Resources](#) to enhance and complement state, local and territorial health department responses to COVID-19.
- **June 8** - The U.S. Department of Labor announced [nearly \\$239 million in dislocated worker grants](#) to be issued in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- **June 8** - [Governor Newsom announced](#) that California-based BYD North America has received certification from the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) to produce 150 million N95 respirators for the state.
- **June 8** - The California Department of Education issued [Stronger Together - a Guidebook for the Safe Reopening of California's Public Schools](#) to help schools plan for reopening in the fall.
