

COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **July 1** – The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) released updated guidance on:
 - [Visiting Beaches and Pools](#).
 - [Interim Considerations for Health Departments for SARS-CoV-2 Testing in Homeless Shelters and Encampments](#).
- **July 1** – The Harvard Global Health Institute released a [COVID Risk Levels Dashboard](#) that displays risk levels for each county in the United States.
- **July 1** – The [California Department of Public Health \(CDPH\) ordered](#) that counties that have been on the County Monitoring List for three consecutive days (including San Bernardino County) to close *indoor activities* taking place in the following sectors for a three-week period:
 - Restaurants
 - Wineries/Tasting Rooms
 - Movie Theaters
 - Family Entertainment Centers
 - Zoos and Museums

In addition, all brewpubs, breweries, bars, and pubs in these counties must close, both indoors and outdoors. CDPH also announced stronger efforts towards enforcement with the establishment of a multi-agency strike team that includes the Alcoholic Beverage Commission, CalOSHA, the Department of Business Oversight, the Department of Consumer Affairs and the California Highway Patrol. These teams will work in partnership with local public health departments and local businesses.

- **July 1** – [CDPH released revised guidance for places of worship](#), requiring places of worship to discontinue singing and chanting activities, and [revised guidance for fitness facilities](#), requiring playground facilities to remain closed.
- **July 1** - [San Bernardino County urges all residents to avoid social gatherings](#) during the upcoming holiday weekend and to avoid the Lytle Creek area for recreation.
