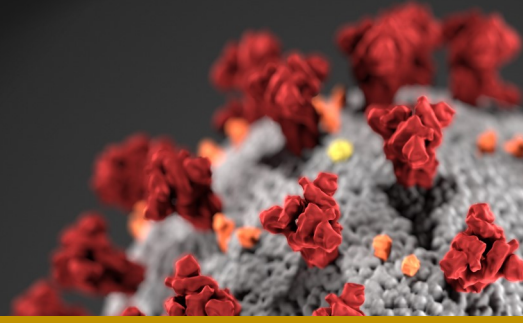


# COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

  - Information on K-12 school reopening in San Bernardino County and state mandates regarding distance learning.
  - Local data indicating a majority of COVID-19 cases within the county stem from private gatherings.
  - Clarification on state mandates for closure of personal care services. Establishments that are within San Bernardino County must close immediately and not offer any services (including any outdoor services).
