

COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **July 22** - The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) provided updated guidance on:
 - The [list of underlying medical conditions](#) that put individuals at increased risk for severe illness from COVID-19.
 - [Electronic Case Reporting \(eCR\) for Healthcare Providers](#). eCR allows the automated generation and transmission of case reports from a provider's electronic health record (EHR) to public health agencies for review and action.
- **July 22** - The CDC provided [a media statement from Dr. Robert R. Redfield on SARS-CoV-2 infections](#), clarifying the CDC's conclusions about antibody data.
- **July 22** - [Governor Newsom has directed the Department of Public Health and Office of Emergency Services to further increase the state's strategic stockpile](#) to 100 million N-95 respirators and 200 million surgical masks by early fall in order to account for the potential need given the recent rise in COVID-19 cases. The Governor's Office of Emergency Services has also entered into a new contract with California-based BYD North America to produce 120 million N-95 respirators and 300 million surgical masks for the state.
