
## COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- August 27 The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) released updated guidance for:
  - Contact Tracing for COVID-19.
  - Investigating a COVID-19 Case.
  - Notification of Exposure: A Contact Tracer's Guide for COVID-19.
- August 26 The CDC issued:
  - Updated recommendations for <u>Preparing K-12 School Administrators for a Safe Return to School in Fall 2020</u>.
  - A <u>Statement</u> on successful prevention and mitigation strategies used at four overnight camps in Maine between June and August 2020. .
  - Updated guidance on <u>Travel During the COVID-19 Pandemic</u>.
  - Updated <u>Operational Considerations for Adapting a Contact Tracing Program to Respond to the</u>
    COVID-19 Pandemic.
  - Updated guidance on <u>Investigating the Impact of COVID-19 during Pregnancy</u>.
  - Updated Worker Safety and Support guidance.
  - Updated <u>Contact Tracing: Frequently Asked Questions</u> for Health Departments.
- August 26 Governor Newsom announced major plans to increase the State's testing capacity and reduce results turnaround time.
- August 25 The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) issued:
  - <u>Elementary School Waiver Consultations</u> which provides the disposition of waiver requests submitted by schools throughout the state.
  - Updated guidance for the California Testing Task Force on sample pooling for COVID-19.
