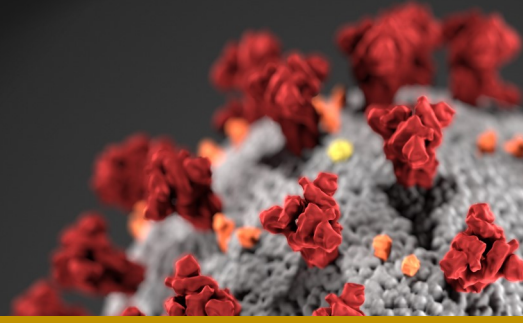


COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **August 29** - The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued updated:
 - Interim Guidance on the [Use of Rapid Antigen Testing for COVID-19](#).

- **August 28** - The CDC released updated guidance on:

 - [Worker Safety and Support](#) for Planning, Preparing and Responding to an Exposure.
- **August 28** - The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) issued a [Statewide Public Health Officer Order](#) which provides an overview of the State's response to COVID-19 and introduces the Governor's Blueprint for a Safer Economy.
- **August 28** - Governor Newsom announced:
 - Signing of an [Executive Order](#) to [Help Increase the State's Testing Capacity](#).
 - The unveiling of [Blueprint for a Safer Economy](#), a statewide, stringent and slow plan for living with COVID-19.
- **August 28** - San Bernardino County announced that, based on the Governor's Blueprint for a Safer Economy, [hair salons, barbers, retail and malls can resume indoor operations on Monday 8/31/20](#).
