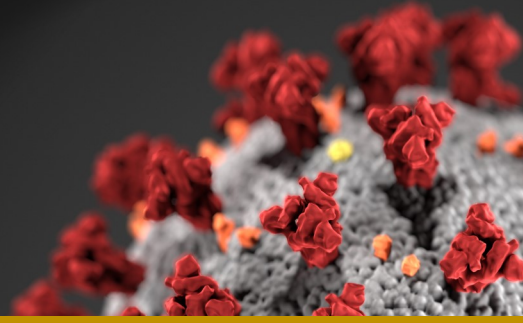


COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **August 5** - The United States Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) and Department of Defense (DoD) announced an [agreement with Johnson & Johnson to produce and deliver millions of doses of the company's COVID-19 investigational vaccine](#). The vaccine doses could be used in clinical trials or distributed as part of a COVID-19 vaccination campaign.
- **August 5** - The National Institutes of Health (NIH) announced:
 - A [Moderna COVID-19 vaccine that shows promise in mouse studies](#). This investigational vaccine is currently being evaluated in Phase 3 of clinical testing due to its ability to protect mice from infection with SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19).
 - The launch of the Medical Imaging and Data Resource Center, an effort that will connect the power of [artificial intelligence and medical imaging to fight COVID-19](#). This collaborative network will create new tools that physicians can use for early detection and personalized therapies for COVID-19 patients.
- **August 4** - The Centers for Disease and Control Prevention (CDC) released updated interim infection prevention and control [Guidance for Dental Settings](#) during the Coronavirus Disease 2019 pandemic.
