This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **August 31** - The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued updated guidance on:

- **August 31** - Governor Newsom announced the signing of a [Statewide COVID-19 Tenant and Landlord Protection Legislation](#) which will protect tenants from eviction through February 1, 2021 due to COVID-related back rent and extends anti-foreclosure protections to small-scale landlords.
- **August 27** - The [Food and Drug Administration \(FDA\) released](#) an updated [FDA's List of Products you Should not Use](#) specific to hand sanitizer products and a [press release](#) warning about hand sanitizer packaged in food and drink containers.
