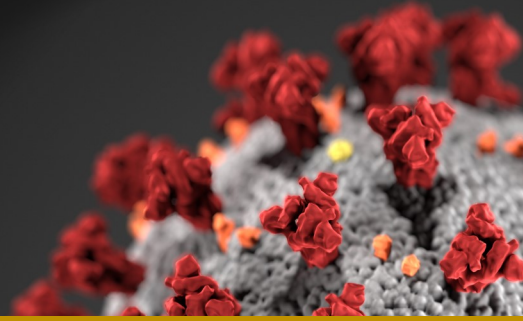


COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **September 10**– The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued updated guidance on what to do [If Your Pet Tests Positive](#) for COVID-19.
- **September 9**– The Trump Administration and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) issued [guidance to expand access to safe and effective COVID-19 vaccines](#) when they are made available.
