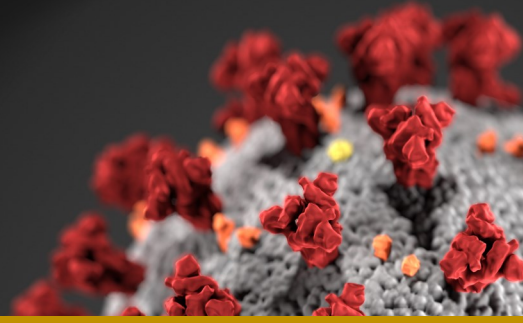


COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **September 10** - The National Institutes of Health (NIH) has launched two of three adaptive Phase Three clinical trials evaluating the safety and effectiveness of varying types of blood thinners to treat individuals diagnosed with COVID-19, particularly those who suffer from life-threatening blood clots.
- **September 10**– The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued updated guidance on:
 - COVID-19 Pandemic Planning Scenarios. The infection fatality ratio parameter was updated to include age-specific estimates and the ratio of estimated infections to reported case counts was added.
 - Clinical Care for patients who are re-infected with SARS-COV-2 after recovering from COVID-19.
- **September 10** - San Bernardino County released an update on when the County will move from the State's purple tier (when COVID-19 is deemed widespread) to red tier (when the outbreak level has decreased to substantial). The County is making steady progress towards the red tier with a current positivity rate of 7.3%.
