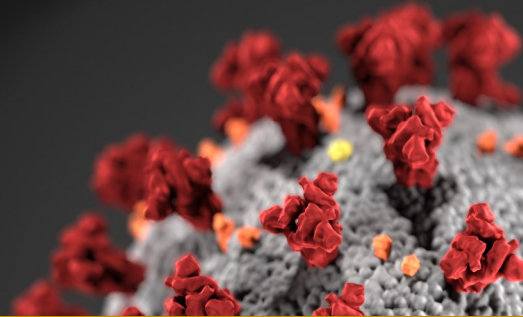


# COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **September 23** - The Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) announced an upcoming action by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to provide \$200 million to jurisdictions for COVID-19 vaccine preparedness.
- **September 22** - San Bernardino County announced:
  - Nail Salons may reopen
  - Modification of rules for restaurants serving alcohol
  - Blood plasma donors are needed, especially from those recovered from COVID-19
- **September 21** - The California Department of Public Health updated the Blueprint for a Safer Economy.
