- **September 23** - The Food and Drug Administration (FDA):
  - [Authorized the first Point-of-Care antibody test for COVID-19.](#)

- **September 23** - The National Institutes of Health (NIH) [announced](#) the beginning of a fourth large-scale COVID-19 vaccine trial.
