This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **September 6-** The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued updated guidance on [Considerations for Restaurants and Bars](#) including guiding principals which describe levels of risk different service environments may present to customers and staff.
- **September 4** - California Department of Public Health issued updated guidance related to [Small Cohorts/Groups of Children and Youth](#).
- **September 4** - San Bernardino County encouraged residents to have a [COVID-Safe Labor Day](#) to allow more businesses to reopen.
- **September 1** - The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) [updated interim policy](#) for determining eligible work and costs for FEMA's emergency Public Assistance Program.
