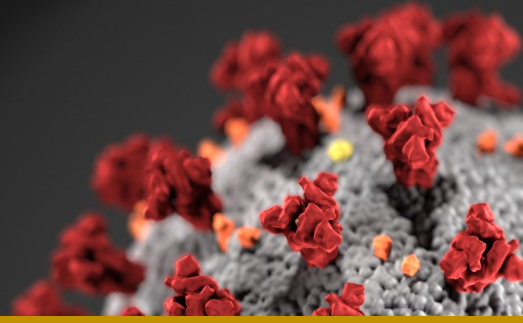


# COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE
