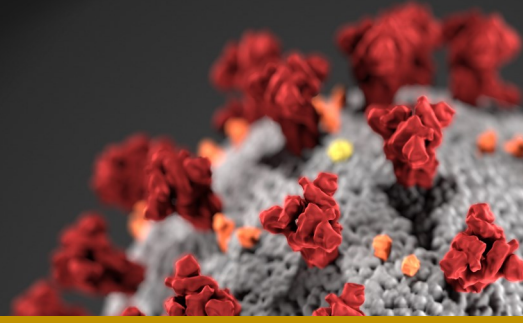


COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **October 28** - The Trump Administration:
 - Acts to Ensure Coverage of Life-Saving COVID-19 Vaccines & Therapeutics.
 - Distributes Incentive Payments to Nursing Homes Curbing COVID-19 Deaths and Infections.
- **October 28** - The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued updated guidance on How COVID-19 Spreads to provide information on instances of reinfection.
- **October 28** - The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services has Collaborated with the Department of Defense on Plans to Purchase Lilly Investigational Therapeutic to Treat COVID-19.
- **October 28** - The National Institutes of Health scientists discover key pathway in lysosomes that coronavirus use to exit cells.
- **October 28** - Governor Newsom:
 - Signed an Executive Order on Actions in Response to COVID-19.
 - Issued an On the Record statement on Staying Housed and Staying Healthy: New Support for California Renters.
