

# COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **November 9** - The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued:
  - Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Report (MMWR)– Early Release related to Characteristics of Hospitalized COVID-19 Patients Discharged and Experiencing Same-Hospital Readmission—United States, March-August 2020.
  - Updated guidance for SARS-CoV-2 Point-of-Care Testing, such as some rapid tests for diagnosing an infectious disease, providing results within minutes of the test being administered and allowing for rapid decisions about patient care.
  - Updated Cleaning, Disinfection and Hand Hygiene in Schools: A Toolkit for School Administrators. Document updated the included handouts regarding disinfecting and key resources pertaining to close contact definition.
- **November 9** - The National Institutes of Health issued a news release describing how Hydroxychloroquine does not benefit adults hospitalized with COVID-19.
- **November 9**– The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) Authorized Monoclonal Antibody Therapy, Bamlanivimab, for Treatment of Mild to Moderate COVID-19 in adult and pediatric patients.
