- **December 8** - President Trump released an [Executive Order](#) on ensuring access to United States Government COVID-19 vaccines.

- **December 8** - San Bernardino County [announced](#) all residents and businesses of San Bernardino County are now under a State mandated Regional Stay Home Order due to an alarming decrease in ICU capacity. The new order went into effect at midnight on Sunday and will remain in place for at least three weeks.
