This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **January 25** - The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) lifts the regional Stay at Home Order for all regions.
- **January 24** - CDPH issued an All Facilities Letter (AFL 21-07) for skilled nursing facilities and general acute care hospitals to maintain efforts to increase staffing levels.
- **January 22** - The White House issued President Biden's new executive actions to deliver economic relief to American families and businesses amid the COVID-19 crisis.
- **January 22** - The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) updated the fact sheet on the allocation rule for exports of personal protective equipment (PPE) to include needles/syringes for COVID-19 vaccination.
- **January 22**– The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued:
 - Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Report early release on allergic reactions including anaphylaxis after receipt of the first dose of Moderna COVID-19 vaccine—United States, December 21, 2020-January 10, 2021.
 - COVID-19 Science Update: Edition 73.
 - Guidance on at-home testing.
 - Updated guidance on what to expect at your vaccine appointment.
