This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **January 25** - President Biden issued a proclamation on the suspension of entry for non-citizens traveling from areas which pose a high risk of transmitting COVID-19.
- **January 25**– The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued:
 - Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Report Early Release: Implementation and evolution of mitigation measures, testing and contact tracing in the national football league August 9- November 21, 2020.
 - Updated information about the:
 - Moderna COVID-19 vaccine.
 - Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine.
 - Training for Healthcare Professionals on various COVID-19 related topics.
- **January 25**– Governor Newsom announced:
 - Actions to simplify, standardize and address vaccine supply needs.
 - Further extension of eviction moratorium.
