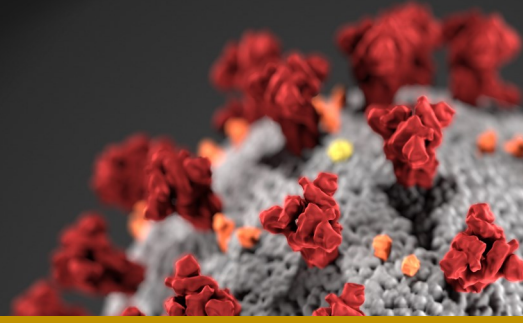


COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **January 5** - The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) posted a new [webpage](#) on the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act highlighting authorities that are intended to enhance the FDA's ability to identify, prevent, and mitigate possible drug shortages by, among other things, enhancing the FDA's visibility into drug supply chains.
- **January 5** - The National Institutes of Health (NIH) announced [a large clinical trial will test combination monoclonal antibody therapy for mild/moderate COVID-19](#).
- **January 5** - The [California Department of Public Health \(CDPH\)](#) issued a [Public Health Order Ensuring Distribution of Health Care Resources across the State to Ensure Patients Get Life-Saving Care as ICU Capacity is Strained](#).
