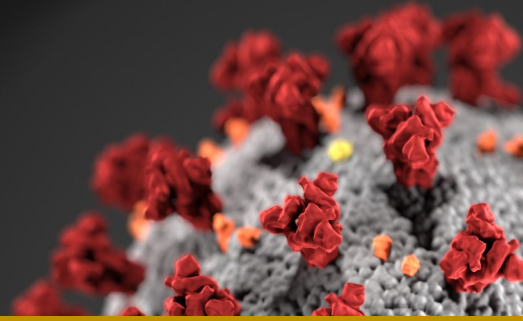


COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **January 13** - The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued:
 - Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Report Early Release: [COVID-19 Trends Among Persons Aged 0-24 Years—United States, March 1-December 12, 2020.](#)

- **January 13**– The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) issued :
 - An announcement that [seniors 65+ are now eligible to receive COVID-19 vaccine.](#)
 - All Facilities Letter ([AFL 21-04](#)) which provides updated notice of timelines for hospital closure, reduction or elimination of Emergency Medical Service and relocation or elimination of supplemental services.
 - All Facilities Letter ([AFL 21-05](#)) which provides guidance on the process for fit-testing resource requests specific to skilled nursing facilities.
- **January 13** - San Bernardino County [announced](#) that the county has moved into Tier 3 of vaccination phase 1A which includes those working at specialty clinics, laboratories, dental and oral health clinics and pharmacy staff.
