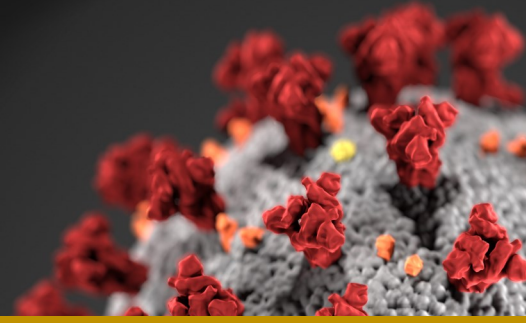


COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **January 30** - The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued updated guidance on:
 - [How to protect yourself and others](#) from COVID-19 to include an advisory that masks are required when using public transportation of any kind.
 - What [paratransit operators](#), [transit station workers](#), [bus transit operators](#) and [rail transit operator](#)s need to know about COVID-19.
 - What [rideshare](#), [taxi](#), [limo](#) and [other passenger drivers-for-hire](#) need to know about COVID-19.
- **January 29** - The National Institutes of Health (NIH) issued a [news release on Janssen investigational COVID-19 vaccine](#) and interim analysis and release of phase 3 clinical data.
- **January 29** - Governor Newsom [signed legislation](#) to extend eviction moratorium and assist tenants and small property owners impacted by COVID-19.
- **January 28** - NIH reported on [severe COVID-19 in pregnancy associated with preterm birth and other complications](#).
