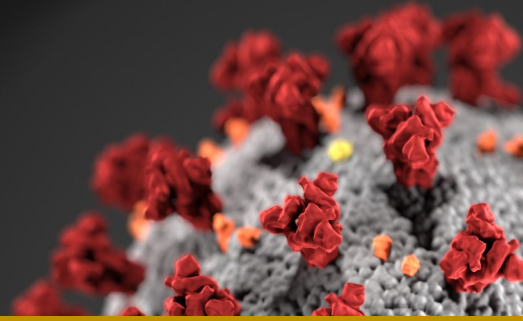


COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **February 2** - The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued updated guidance on [Employer information](#) for transit maintenance workers.
- **February 1** - The CDC issued:

- **February 1** - The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) issued an All Facilities Letter ([AFL 21-09](#)) providing information on additional temporary waivers tied to the hospital surge public health order.
- **January 31** - Health and Human Services (HHS) Secretary, Alex M. Azar II [declares a public health emergency for the entire United States](#) to aid the nation's healthcare community in responding to COVID-19.
- **January 29** - CDPH issued an All Facilities Letter ([AFL 21-08](#)) providing guidance on quarantine for health care personnel exposed to COVID-19.
