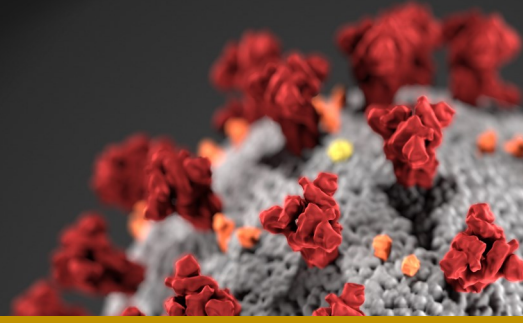


# COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **February 22-** The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued:
  - Updated guidance on:

- **February 22** - The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) updated [Emergency Use Authorization for Vaccines to Prevent COVID-19](#) to provide recommendations to vaccine developers seeking to amend their EUA to address new virus variants.
- **February 22** - The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) issued an All Facilities Letter ([AFL 21-10](#)) which changes the way health care facility licenses are issued.
- **February 17** - The National Institutes of Health (NIH) funds a [study to evaluate remdesivir for COVID-19 in pregnancy.](#)
