This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **February 2** - The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued updated guidance on:
 - [New variant of virus](#) that causes COVID-19 detected.
 - CDC's [influenza SARS-COV-2 multiplex assay and required supplies](#) to add information on CDC amendment granted by FDA on January 8, 2021.
 - [COVID-19 in newly resettled refugee populations](#).
 - [Agriculture workers and employers](#).
- **February 2** - San Bernardino County announced that the 3,500 COVID-19 vaccine appointments for the vaccination event held at the [Auto Club Speedway super site](#) were filled within 20 minutes of opening and that more super site events will be planned in the near future.
- **February 1** - The Department of Defense (DOD) [awarded a \\$231.8 million contract to Ellume USA LLC](#) to increase domestic production capacity and deliver COVID-19 home tests.
- **January 29** - The U.S. Department of Labor Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) issued [updated guidance](#) on mitigating and preventing the spread of COVID-19 in the workplace.
