

# COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **March 18** - The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Reports (MMWR) on:
  - [SARS-CoV-2 transmission associated with high school football team members](#) - Florida, September-October 2020.
  - [Minimal SARS-CoV-2 transmission after implementation of a comprehensive mitigation strategy at a school](#) - New Jersey, August 20-November 27, 2020.
  - [The association of children’s mode of school instruction with child and parent experiences of well-being during the COVID-19 pandemic](#) – COVID Experiences Survey, United States, October 8-November 13, 2020.
- **March 18** - The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) [authorized issuance of revised fact sheets](#) in order to address SARS-CoV-2 variants for monoclonal antibody products administered under emergency use authorization (EUA).
- **March 18** - Governor Newsom and State Superintendent Thurmond announced [deployment of up to three million free rapid COVID-19 antigen tests](#) to help high-needs schools to safely reopen classrooms.
- **March 18** - San Bernardino County [announced](#):
  - The county’s COVID-19 Vaccine Equity group works to ensure doses are available for all residents.
  - That as a result of the county now being in tier red, the following establishments are reopening:
    - San Bernardino County Museum
    - Regional movie theaters
