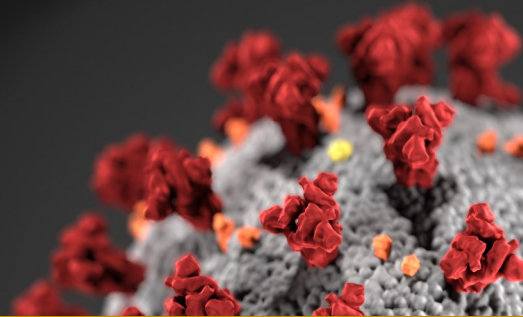


COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **March 1** - The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued updated guidance on:

- **March 1** - Governor Gavin Newsom announced:
 - The federal government [confirmed](#) COVID-19 [vaccine sites will not conduct immigration enforcement operations](#) and site staff are not immigration officials.
 - [Agreement on a \\$6.6 billion budget package](#) to accelerate the safe return to in-person instruction across California.
- **March 1** - The California Department of Education released a [statement](#) in response to legislative deal on school reopening.
