This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **March 23** - The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued updated guidance on what you can do [when you've been fully vaccinated](#). The guidance is updated to advise that those living in group setting who have been in contact with a person sick with COVID-19 should stay away from others for 14 days and get tested even if they have no symptoms.
- **March 22** - The CDC issued updated guidance on:
 - [COVID-19 vaccination for people experiencing homelessness](#). Guidance updated for the different vaccines available and which vaccines require two doses.
 - [Evaluation for COVID-19 testing in animals](#) to provide updated information on testing North American wildlife and the new confirmatory testing process for animals
- **March 22** - The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) announced the state's online COVID-19 vaccine scheduling tool, [My Turn, is offering services in a total of 12 languages](#).
- **March 20** - CDPH issued [updated K-12 Schools Reopening Framework and Guidance](#) to reflect changes in physical distancing requirements and use of physical barriers.
