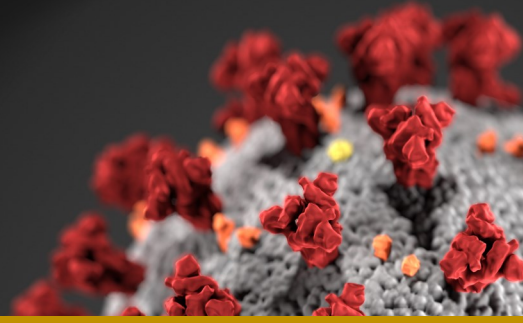


COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

- **March 2** - The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued:
