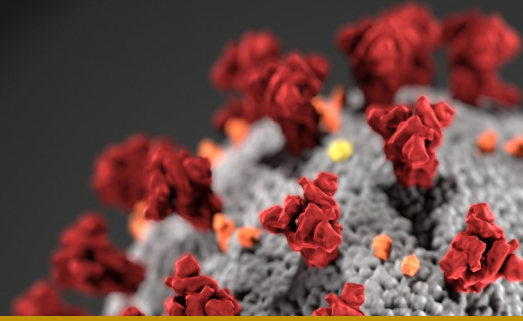


# COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **March 29** - President Biden [announced](#) 90% of the adult U.S. population will be eligible for vaccination and 90% will have a vaccination site within five miles of home by April 19.
- **March 29** - The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued:
  - Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Report early release on [interim estimates of vaccine effectiveness of BNT162b2 and mRNA-1273 COVID-19 vaccines in preventing SARS-CoV-2 infection among health care personnel, first responders and other essential and frontline workers](#)—eight U.S. locations, December 2020-March 2021.
