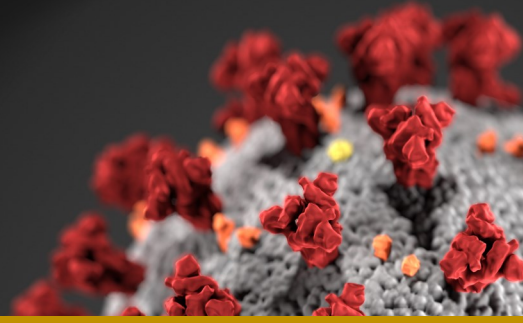


COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **April 9-** The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued:
 - COVID-19 Science Update [edition 84](#) providing science publications relating to the following topics:
 - Detection, burden and impact.
 - Transmission.
 - Protection in healthcare and non-healthcare work settings.
 - Prevention, mitigation and intervention strategies.
 - COVID-19 vaccines in immunocompromised people.
 - Guidance for [reporting SARS-CoV-2 sequencing results](#) relating to reporting instructions and examples.
- **April 9 -** The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) issued a [letter to health care personnel and facilities](#) recommending transitioning away from use of decontaminated disposable respirators.
- **April 9 -** San Bernardino County [announced](#) emergency rent and utilities relief coming soon for county residents . Assistance applications will be accepted Monday 4/12/21 and continue through 12/31/2021, or until funds are exhausted, whichever comes first.
