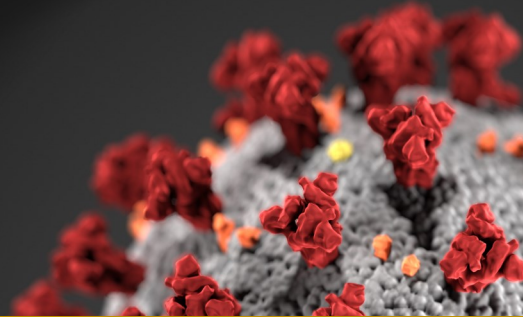


COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **April 14**- The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued a Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Report early release on [laboratory modeling of SARS-CoV-2 exposure reduction through physically distanced seating in aircraft cabins using bacteriophage aerosol](#)—November 2020.
- **April 13** - The National Institutes of Health (NIH) posted an article on [mapping severe COVID-19 in the lungs at single-cell resolution](#).
- **April 13**– The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) issued a [statement](#) on Johnson & Johnson/Janssen COVID-19 Vaccine, recommending a pause in administration of this vaccine until further investigation may be completed.
- **April 13** - San Bernardino County [pauses use of Johnson & Johnson vaccine](#) in response to six reported cases of a rare and severe type of blood clot in individuals after receiving this vaccine. None of the cases were in California.
