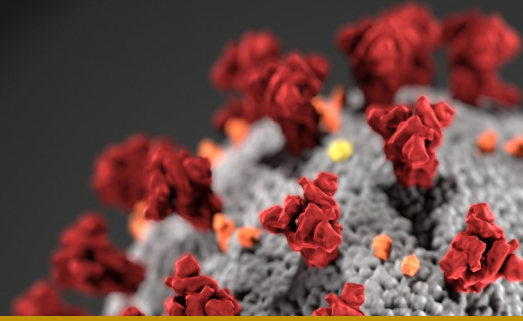


# COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **April 16** - The Biden Administration announced:
  - [\\$1.7 billion investment in CDC, states and other jurisdictions](#) to monitor, track and fight emerging COVID-19 variants.
  - \$4 billion in American Rescue Plan funding will [expand COVID-19 vaccinations, testing, treatment and preventative health services for American Indians and Alaska Natives](#).
- **April 15**– The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Reports on:
  - [COVID-19 and influenza discharge diagnoses as a percentage of emergency department visits](#), by year—United States, June 2018-March 2021.

- **April 15** - Governor Newsom [announced](#) that all Californians aged 16+ are now eligible for COVID-19 vaccines.
