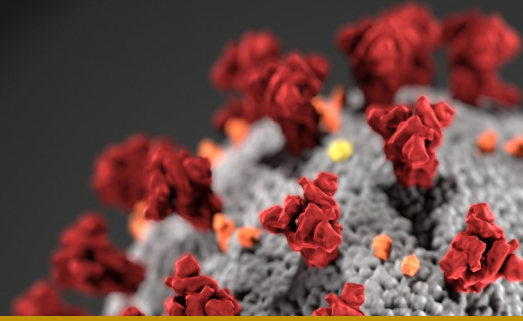


# COVID-19 ADVISORY & GUIDANCE UPDATE

This update summarizes news, guidance, advisories, and legislative and executive actions taken by federal, state and local governments that impact San Bernardino County and its response to the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) crisis.

- **April 7-** The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued:
  - Guidance on [COVID-19 employer information for office buildings](#).
  - Expanded information on the [Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System \(VAERS\)](#).
- **April 6** - The CDC issued:
  - [Customizable COVID-19 vaccination content](#) for health departments and other public health partners.
  - [Resources for sharing real-time vaccine information](#).
  - Information on [reporting county-level COVID-19 vaccination data](#).
- **April 6** - The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) issued an [emergency use authorization \(EUA\) for the Symbiotica COVID-19 self-collected antibody test system](#).
- **April 6** - The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) [announced](#) four million COVID-19 doses delivered to California's hardest-hit communities, prompting update to the state's Reopening Plan.
- **April 6** - Governor Newsom outlined his [plan to reopen the state's economy completely on June 15](#).
- **April 6** - San Bernardino County [announced](#):
  - Vaccinations are now available to all residents aged 16 and older.
  - The county enters the orange tier on Wednesday, April 7, which will allow further lowering of restrictions on businesses reopening.
