



SECOND BOOSTER DOSE SELF-ATTESTATION OF ELIGIBILITY

SELF-ATTESTATION FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE ELIGIBLE FOR A SECOND BOOSTER DOSE OF PFIZER-BIONTECH (COMIRNATY) OR MODERNA (SPIKEVAX) COVID-19 VACCINE

It is recommended that individuals receive a booster as soon as they are eligible to maintain a strong immunity against COVID-19. You may receive a second booster dose following completion of your primary vaccination series and first booster dose.

If you received Pfizer-BioNTech (Comirnaty) or Moderna (Spikevax), then you are eligible for a second booster if you...

Received your first booster dose at least four months ago, and meet any **ONE** of the following requirements:

- Age [50 years or older](#)
- Age 12 years or older who are [moderately to severely immunocompromised*](#):
 - ✓ Been receiving active cancer treatment for tumors or cancers of the blood
 - ✓ Received an organ transplant and are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
 - ✓ Received a stem cell transplant within the last 2 years or are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
 - ✓ Moderate or severe primary immunodeficiency (such as DiGeorge syndrome, Wiskott-Aldrich syndrome)
 - ✓ Advanced or untreated HIV infection
 - ✓ Active treatment with high-dose corticosteroids or other drugs that may suppress their immune response

**Note: Children aged 17 years and younger may only receive the Pfizer-BioNTech (Comirnaty) COVID-19 vaccine.*

If you received a primary dose AND booster dose Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) then you are eligible for a second booster if you...

- Received your first booster dose at least four months ago, and
- Age 18 years or older
