Novavax Now Available to Order

As of July 27, 2022, providers may begin ordering Novavax through myCAvax and the [County Vaccine Request Form](#). The first vials to be shipped will have a nine-month expiry date, and the vials will not have an expiration date listed on the label. This month, multiple vaccine products received emergency use authorizations (EUA) by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration. County Opt-Out for Ancillary Kits Not Available for Certain Vaccines

As of July 5, **providers will no longer have the option** to opt-out of receiving ancillary supplies for County vaccine shipments for the following products:

- Pfizer BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine (5-11 years)
- Pfizer BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine (6 months-4 years)

Providers can continue to opt-out of ancillary supplies when placing standard orders shipped from manufacturers and/or County deliveries for vaccines that are not listed here. We thank you for your continued collaboration in our vaccination efforts.

KidsVaxGrant Opportunity Exclusively for Vaccines for Children (VFC) Providers

The State of California is now offering grant funding to medical organizations enrolled in the federal VFC Program, vaccinating eligible children from birth through 18 years of age. VFC providers newly enrolled in California's COVID-19 vaccine program (myCAvax) could qualify for \$10,000 to support enrollment and launch a vaccination center. VFC providers currently enrolled in [myCAvax](#), who are expanding operating hours could be eligible for \$15,000.
