CONTINUATION OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

As of July 15, 2022, the HHS Secretary Becerra declared a renewal of the Public Health Emergency for 90 Days. This allows healthcare providers as well as public health departments to have continued support and flexibility to respond to the pandemic. HHS will provide states and local health jurisdictions with at least 60 days' notice prior to the termination of the public health emergency declaration for COVID-19. EVUSHELD REPORTING

As of July 7, 2022, Evusheld was authorized for repeat dosing every 6 months. Please continue to report inventory and administration in the Health Partner Ordering Portal (HPOP). The Office of the Assistant Secretary for Preparedness and Response (ASPR) and HPOP team would like to remain consistent with historical reporting, please continue reporting 2 administrations or cartons per patient. As a note, reporting of Evusheld administrations should always be an even number. For example, if 2 patients received Evusheld, report in HPOP as "4" (2 patients = 4, cartons = 8 vials). If you have been reporting differently (as 600 mg units), please reach out to COVID19Therapeutics@hhs.gov.

RENAL PAXLOVID SUPPLY DISRUPTION

Renal Paxlovid supply is temporarily constrained due to shipping delays. Please be mindful of this when placing requests to receive this treatment and only order what is needed. This supply disruption is predicted to last for approximately 2 weeks.

NON-COMPLIANT ACCOUNTS

California Department of Public Health (CDPH) has identified several sites that have not completed inventory reporting within HPOP. These facilities are considered noncompliant and are at risk of being denied future allocations of therapeutics. **As reminder, reporting is required for all COVID-19**

Therapeutics, twice a week on Monday and Thursday no later than 8:59 p.m. PST. San Bernardino County's therapeutic thresholds are directly impacted by the consistency of reporting. If you are worried your account is not in compliance, please email SBCOVID19Therapeutics@dph.sbcounty.gov.
