On Monday, January 16, 2023, San Bernardino County and state offices will be closed in observance of the Martin Luther King Jr. holiday. Please note, this will affect vaccine delivery schedules and there will be no deliveries Monday, 01/16/2023.

COVID-19 Vaccine Shipping Delays

Please be aware that McKesson is experiencing shipment delays due to adverse weather conditions. We currently do not have information on expected delivery time frames for impacted orders. Pfizer and Moderna products have received shelf-life extensions. Please note, these Lot Expiration checkers refer to manufacturer printed expiration dates. If you have received doses refrigerated, there is a limited-time usage of these vaccines that would not apply (i.e Pfizer

Products 10 weeks refrigerated, and Moderna Products 30 days refrigerated).
