SHELF LIFE EXTENSION FOR PAXLOVID

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has authorized a shelf-life extension to 24 months for specific lots of Paxlovid. Please be sure you are checking the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services regularly for updates on all extend shelf-life dates as the website is updated frequently. Additionally, be sure you check all inventory lots for any extensions. Most, if not all expiration dates printed on the box are not up to date.

REMINDER TO CONTINUE REPORTING

Reminder that reporting is required weekly on Thursdays, no later than 11:59 p.m. EST regardless of the number of treatments you have administered. All products that were obtained from the United States Government must be reported within the HPOP system. This includes any Bebtelovimab that was received. There is no reporting requirement for any Bebtelovimab treatments that were purchased directly from the manufacturer. Failure to comply with the reporting cadence may result in a loss or delay in receiving treatments requested.
